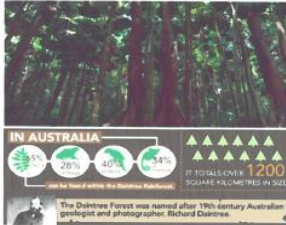


QLD FAUNA
